**Please note:**

- This carnival is not a competitive event as we would like children to enjoy and have fun playing Kidznet.
- Schools can send unlimited number of teams.
- KidzNet Rules and Netball Rules shall apply (Children have to rotate in their playing positions at half time).
- There shall be a max. of 10 players per team.
- No Prizes will be awarded (Non-competitive).
- An email will be sent to confirm your participation of the carnival.

### Terms and Conditions:

1. Netball Singapore reserves the right to postpone or cancel the carnival.
2. In the event of cancellation, all schools will be informed well in advance.
3. In the event of bad weather, the organisers will make the decision to postpone or cancel the carnival if rain persists after 30 mins of the game time. If the games have started, play will continue if it is a slight drizzle. Postponed games will be played on the following Saturday (from 8am onwards).
4. If schools wish to withdraw from the carnival, schools have to notify organisers in writing. A letter of notification must be submitted to Netball Singapore **at least 1 week** before the carnival commences (email to [eric.lee@netball.org.sg](mailto:eric.lee@netball.org.sg)).
5. In the case for **late withdrawals** (ie less than 1 week notification), schools must pay **\$50** for the late notification. This represents the administrative charges for the booking of courts and arrangements of umpires made for the carnival.
6. Each participating school must be accompanied by a teacher who shall remain with the team throughout the duration of play. The teacher is responsible for the well-being of their players.
7. Every school **must** bring their own **first aid kit** and playing **bibs (at least 2 sets of different colours per team)**.
8. Netball Singapore will not be responsible or in any way liable for personal injury or accidents or loss of property whatsoever arising, during and after the carnival.
