- Remember to print the certificate and save a soft copy (You may re-access your results on the same day, after which the server will remove it)



There are 12 parts to the Exam including multiple choice and Yes/No questions.

To pass you must score at least 70%. If you score less than 70% you will need to complete the exam again to be registered as a pass with Netball Australia, your State Netball Organisation and your local Association/Club.

If you score less than 70% you can repeat the exam however you may not see your score or the answers before re-attempting.

If for any reason the exam appears to freeze (this could be due to a disruption to your internet connection) please shut down your internet browser (eg dose Explorer, Safari or Firefox) log back in to www.netballaustralia.coursehost.com and continue your exam.

If you pass and you wish to repeat the exam (to get a better score) click on the "My Home" button and then click on "drop". You can then repeat the exam.

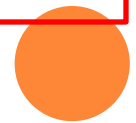
