Umpires	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Netball Singapore will supply the Umpires for all matches.
Entry Form & Team list	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This will be a Women's event only. Teams must submit their entries using the entry form and team list provided. Submit full names of every player and coach.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No player will be permitted to play in the competition unless she has been registered with a team. Should a team field an unregistered player, the results of the matches played with the offending player will be nullified and the opposing team will be given the winning points. In addition, for leagues, the offending club will have 2 points deducted from their total accumulated round robin points. • There will be a maximum 12 teams per division, split into 2 groupings. • All Clubs will be restricted to a maximum of 2 teams. Additional teams will be placed under waiting list. • No changes to team list after closing date. • Call 6346 5063 Ext 119/120 to verify your entries are received. • Entry forms to be sent to: events@netball.org.sg
<p>Scoring and Time Keeping</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Central timing by Netball Singapore • Each team will provide their own scorecards. The coaches of each team will do the scoring due to the safety restrictions. If your team does not have a coach, a scorer must be appointed. • Coaches/Scorers must tally their scores during their intervals and at the end of each match. • The team captains must request the umpires to verify the scores and scorecards and submit immediately to the Tournament Officials. • Teams that are late for 5 minutes will be deemed to have given a walkover.
<p>Postponements of Games</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teams that wish to postpone their game personally will have to inform Netball Singapore 5 days in advance. • Netball Singapore will not be providing courts and umpires for both teams who wish to rearrange their matches.
<p>Safety Rules</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All teams must strictly abide by the venue rules at KNC. If in doubt, you must approach the safety officers for advice. • Players must be masked until they are on the court for their warmup. They must wear their masks again as soon as they leave the court after their game. • Coaches & scorers (if your team does not have a coach) must be masked and must <u>remain outside the court at all times</u>. Coaches are allowed to coach for both the sessions in one day. • Players, substitutes and coaches from both teams have to be on one side of the court as directed by NS. Only the umpire will be on the other side of the court as required by the safety measures. • Teams playing in the first session each day can get on the court by 7pm. They must leave KNC by 8pm sharp. You will have about 15 minutes after your game to cool down. • The balls will be disinfected by NS staff between games.

<p style="text-align: center;">Event Administration</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Random checks of players' identity may be conducted from time to time. • Protests or complaints must be submitted in writings within 48 hours of the incident and must be accompanied by the protest fee of \$50. • It is the team responsibility to inform Netball Singapore any walkover game 5 working days in advance. Failure to do so will have to pay an additional penalty of \$20.
<p style="text-align: center;">First Aid & Insurance</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Team players are to provide own first aid kit and ice packs to treat injuries. • All players are advised to purchase personal accident insurance.
<p style="text-align: center;">Liability</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Netball Singapore and its employees, officials and sponsors shall not be liable for any accidents, injuries, loss of personal properties that may have been suffered during this event. • Netball Singapore has the right to use any photographs, motion pictures, recordings, or any other record of the Event for any legitimate purpose, including commercial advertising.

3 V 3 STREET NETBALL RULES

TEAMS

- Each team will only be allowed to register 4 players and 1 coach or scorer (if your team does not have a coach).
- The game will be a 3 vs 3 match, played on a half court with one rolling substitute.
- Any 2 players from each team are allowed in the goal circle.
- Should an injury be serious, teams will be allowed to replace the injured player, but only from the next game onwards. NS must approve of the change at least 1 day before the next game.
- Should you need to change the coach or scorer, NS must be informed at least 1 working day ahead of your match.
- All teams must have 2 different colored sets of 4 bibs/ team gear for their game. The first named team will have the first choice of bib colour should there be a clash.

DURATION

- The duration of each game is 2 halves of 10minutes each with a 3-minute break.
- The clock will not be stopped for injuries. If an injury is called the player must leave the court immediately.
- The games will be started and stopped (for half time and end of game) centrally for all courts. There will be no time-keeping for individual courts.
- It will be deemed a walkover if your team is late for more than a minute.
- Teams are encouraged to report at their respective courts 3 to 5 minutes before their games.

STARTING PLAY/RESTARTING PLAY

- A Toss Up will be held between two opposing players at Centre circle to start the game.
- Play continues from the toss up i.e. the umpire does not blow the whistle to start.
- For the rest of the game, the team which does not score will take the next Centre Pass.

TURNOVERS

- When possession of the ball is turned over the team in possession shall play the ball back over the transverse line.
- A team member must catch or land with the ball with both feet on the ground past the transverse line before continuing to play the ball back towards the goal.
- There will be no stop in play; the team having completed the crossing of the transverse line may immediately continue playing the ball.
- If a defending player tips or deflects the ball it is not a turnover unless the other team gets possession.

SUBSTITUTION

- There is no limit to the number of substitutions per team in a game.
- Rolling substitutions are allowed for both teams after either team scores a goal.
- The game will not be stopped for this.
- There will be no stoppages for injuries. The player can be replaced immediately for an injury.

All other netball rules under "INF Rules of Netball 2020" will apply.
