Format:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 6 minutes halves • Round Robin Format shall be used for Round 1. Single Knockout Format shall be used in Round 2. • Netball Singapore reserves the right to change the format without prior notice. • Netball Singapore reserves the right to cancel the category that has less than 5 teams. • Netball Singapore reserves the right to decide on postponement in the case of inclement weather or other circumstances.
Umpires:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All teams are to provide their own student/teacher umpire and finger grip whistle for this carnival. • NS will allocate the umpire into the various umpiring slot. Please note that they may not be allocated at the same timing as their team playing slot. (If the school is playing in morning, the umpiring slot might be in afternoon and vice versa). • Umpires do not have to be in full white. • Teachers, coaches, and players (spectators) must understand that these player umpires are not trained, therefore they will need to be patient with them.
Prizes:	12 medals per team for the top 3 teams in each category.

Entry Form & Team List	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teams are required to submit their entries on the official entry form provided or via our website. • All team players' names must be submitted before the closing date. • Each team shall register a minimum of 7 players and no more than 12 players. • Any changes made to the team list after the closing date must have a valid reason (for example, injury) and must be approved by Netball Singapore in writing. • Please send the entry form via Email – events@netball.org.sg
Payment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tournament fees are to be paid prior to the start of the event. • Payment can be made via bank transfer DBS Current Account 004-021181-2, PayNow UEN S63SS0051C or head down to our office for cash payment. We accept e-invoice as payment from schools. • Tournament fees remain payable in the case of withdrawal after closing date.
Tournament Rules	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For the Year End Carnival 2024, Netball Singapore Tournament Rules https://www.netball.org.sg/event/netball-singapore-tournament-rules/shall apply. • Umpires will be applying the latest INF new rules 2024 for all categories https://netball.sport/game/the-rules-of-netball • Each Player is only allowed to play for one team in each category. • For teams playing in the 10&U Schools/Clubs category, 2.6 metre goal post and size 4 ball will be used.
Scoring and Time keeping	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Central timing by Netball Singapore. • Each team must provide their own scorecards. You may use your own scorecards or purchased a set from Netball Singapore at \$2.00 for 10 pieces. • Each team must provide 1 scorer. • Scorers must tally their scores during the intervals and at the end of each match. • The team captains must request the Umpires to verify the scores on the scorecards and submit them immediately to the Tournament officials. • Teams that are late for 2 minutes will be deemed to have given a walkover

Event Administration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only Netball Singapore Members (for Clubs) and MOE Registered School (for Schools) are eligible to take part in this carnival. • Random checks of players' identity may be conducted from time to time. • Protests or complaints must be submitted in writing within 48 hours of the incident and must be accompanied by the protest fee of \$50.00. • Netball Singapore reserves the right to decide on postponement in the case of inclement weather or other circumstances. • In the event that the carnival may not be completed in time during the reserve date, the games will be stopped, and the final results will be determined by a penalty shootout amongst those teams still in the running for the finals. 4 shooters from each team will have 1 shot each from a designated point decided by Netball Singapore. In the event of a draw after the 4 shots, the highest drawn teams will continue shooting in a sudden death format (1 further throw for each team using the same 4 shooters in rotation) until the winners are determined.
First Aid	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teams are to provide their own first aid kit and ice packs to treat injuries. • All players are advised to purchase personal accident insurance.
