EVENT RULES & REGULATIONS	
Payment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All fees (tournament and umpire fees) are to be paid by the closing date. Payment can be made via bank transfer to DBS Current Account 004-021181-2 (Netball Singapore) or PayNow to UEN No. S63SS0051C. Tournament fees remain payable in case of withdrawal after the closing date.
Entry Form & Team List	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Teams can submit their registration to events@netball.org.sg. Please allow 1 working day for our team to respond to you. Please call to verify that your entry form and name list have been received. No appeals shall be entertained because of transmission error. Each team can register a minimum of 7 players and no more than 12 players. All players are only allowed to participate in ONE team per category. A player can be part of a team in Women Open and Mixed Open, but not in 2 teams in Women Open. Team list shall be submitted by the closing date and no changes shall be made after the closing date. Random checks of players' identity may be conducted from time to time.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Protests or complaints must be submitted in writing within 48 hours of the incident and must be accompanied by the protest fee of \$50.
Team Umpires	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Team Umpires must minimally hold a Level 1 Umpiring qualification with Netball Singapore. Mixed Open teams are required to provide their own qualified Team Umpire. Team Umpires will be assigned to matches by Netball Singapore.
Format of Play	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 7-minute halves (subject to change). Round 1 will follow a Round Robin format, while Round 2 will be played using a Single Knockout format. Netball Singapore reserves the right to change the format or cancel the category with less than 5 teams without prior notice. Netball Singapore also retains the right to the arrangement of fixtures.
Tournament Rules	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mixed Open – A minimum of 1 and maximum of 3 male players are allowed to take the court at any one time. The male players must play either a GS or GA; GK or GD; C, WA or WD (one male player per area of court). Netball Singapore Tournament Rules shall apply for this event. https://www.netball.org.sg/event/netball-singapore-tournament-rules/ Umpires will be applying the latest INF rules 2024 for all categories, including the school categories. https://netball.sport/game/the-rules-of-netball All teams are required to play on all playing days stated.
Scoring and Time Keeping	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The carnival will run on centralised timing done by Netball Singapore. Each team must provide their own scorecards and 1 scorer. Scorers are to tally the scores during the intervals and at the end of each match. Team captains must request the Umpires to verify the scorers written and submit them immediately to the scoring table. Teams that are late for 2 or more minutes will be deemed to have given a walkover.
Event Administration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Netball Singapore reserves the right to decide on postponement in the case of inclement weather or other circumstances. If the carnival cannot be completed in time due to inclement weather, the games will be stopped. The decision to continue (with the same or different format) or postpone shall be made by Netball Singapore and the decision is final. Any carnival matches played past the half-time mark, and uncompleted due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances, shall be taken as completed and scores accepted. Any carnival matches before the half time mark, shall be postponed to a reserve date/time and replayed.
First Aid	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> There will be no ambulance on standby for this event. Teams are to provide their own first aid kit and ice packs to treat injuries. All players are advised to purchase personal accident insurance.

Liability

- Netball Singapore and its employees, officials and sponsors shall not be liable for any accidents, injuries, loss of personal properties that may have been suffered during this event.
- Netball Singapore has the right to use any photographs, motion pictures, recordings, or any other recording during the event for any legitimate purpose, including commercial advertising.

- Prize money will be awarded for the 23&U Tertiary/Club, Women Open, and Mixed Open categories. If less than a minimum of 10 teams take part in the category, teams will be awarded **medals only**.
