1. Cash prizes

- Cash prizes will be awarded to the top 3 teams for the Club Women and Club Mixed categories:

Categories	1 st	2 nd	3 rd
Club Women Division 1	\$500	\$350	\$250
Club Women Division 2	\$300	\$250	\$200
Club Women Division 3 – 7	\$250	\$200	\$150
Club Mixed	\$200	\$150	\$100

2. Competition format

- Minimum of 7 teams and maximum of 9 teams to form a Division/Grouping.
- Netball Singapore reserves the right to determine the final assignment of teams to the respective divisions.
- Clubs participating in the 2027 Netball Super League (NSL) must participate in Division 1 of the 2026 National League.
- Registration of 2026 NSL players is subject to the following caps:
 - Division 1: No limit
 - Division 2: Maximum of 4 NSL players
 - Division 3: Maximum of 2 NSL players
- The league will adopt a round robin format. All games shall be played in 4 quarters of 15 minutes, with quarter-time intervals of 3 minutes and half-time intervals of 5 minutes.
- In the event of unforeseen circumstances, Netball Singapore reserves the right to change the tournament format without prior notice.

3. Entry Form & Team List

- The National and Age Group Squads will compete in the following Divisions:
 - 19&U: Division 2
 - 17&U: Division 3
- These Squads shall be exempted from the promotion and relegation protocols.
- Entries requesting more than 1-week exemptions from play will not be accepted.
- Each team shall register a minimum of 7 players and no more than 15 players. However, only 12 players can be named for any given match.
- A minimum of 5 players (must include a Centre) are required to start a game.
- **All team players' names must be submitted by 8 May 2026, 12pm.** No changes can be made to the team list thereafter. In exceptional circumstances (e.g. season-ending injury, as verified by a medical professional), Netball Singapore, may on a case-by-case basis permit the replacement of a player by another player.
- Each player is only allowed to play for one team in each category.
- Teams are required to submit their entries on the official entry form by the closing date.
- **Entries are to be emailed to events@netball.org.sg.** Please allow 2-3 working days for our team to reply with confirmation of registration before making any payment.
- **Tournament fees remain payable in the case of withdrawal after the closing date.**
- No player will be permitted to play in the competition unless s/he has been registered with the team. Should a team field an unregistered player, the results of the matches played with the offending player will be nullified and the opposing team will be given the winning points. In addition, the offending team will have 2 points deducted from its total accumulated round robin points.

4. Club Mixed Category

- A minimum of 1 and a maximum of 3 male players are allowed to take court at any one time. Male players must either play either GS or GA; GK or GD; C, WA or WD (i.e. one male player per area of court).

5. Tournament Rules

- Netball Singapore Tournament Rules (<https://www.netball.org.sg/event/netball-singapore-tournament-rules/>) shall apply.
- Umpires will apply the latest INF Rules (2024) (<https://netball.sport/game/the-rules-of-netball/>).
- All teams are to abide by Netball Singapore's Safe Sport Policy (see Annex A).

6. Scoring and Timekeeping



- Each team must provide 1 scorer and 1 timekeeper at each match.
- Competition balls (Molten) will be provided by Netball Singapore.
- The starting seven (including their starting positions) and reserve players must be filled up on the scorecard before the start of the game.
- Scorers must tally their scores during the intervals and at the end of each match.
- The team captains must request the Umpires to verify the scores on the scorecards, which are to be submitted to the event organiser immediately after each game.
- Point System: Win = 2 points, Draw = 1 point, Loss = 0 point, and deduction of 2 points for awarding of a walkover.
- **Teams that are late for 5 minutes from the scheduled match start time will be deemed to have given a walkover.**

7. Postponements / Change of Match Format / Groupings

- Netball Singapore reserves the rights to decide on a postponement date in the event of inclement weather or other circumstances, and no appeals shall be entertained.
- Reserved games will be held on Friday evenings. In the event that there are too many reserved games, Netball Singapore may allocate the games to other weekday nights, subject to available courts.
- Teams that wish to postpone their game must inform Netball Singapore **at least 5 days in advance**.
- Netball Singapore will not provide courts and umpires for both teams who wish to rearrange their matches.

8. Abandoned Matches

- Any matches with more than 2 quarters played but not completed because of inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances shall be considered as completed and the scores accepted.
- Any matches with less than 2 quarters played shall be postponed to a reserve date and replayed.
- In the event that the postponed match is abandoned with less than 2 quarters played, a scoreless draw shall be awarded to both teams.

9. Team-Nominated Umpires

- **For teams taking part in Club Women Divisions 1 to 4, the nominated Team Umpires must be badged umpires.**
- All nominated Team Umpires must be qualified umpires in Netball Singapore's database.
- Nominated Team Umpires must report at least 15 minutes prior to the start of their matches, as assigned by Netball Singapore.
- Team Umpires, regardless of the weather, will still need to report for their assigned matches, unless otherwise advised by Netball Singapore.
- If a Team Umpire is late or fails to show up for his/her assignment, 2 points will be deducted from his/her team and a \$50 penalty will be imposed on his/her team.
- Nominated Team Umpires must be able to umpire matches as assigned by Netball Singapore. Team Managers are to ensure that their Team Umpires are able to do so..

10. Event Administration

- Random checks of players' identity may be conducted from time to time.
- Protests or complaints must be submitted in writing within 48 hours of the incident and must be accompanied by a protest fee of \$50.
- It is the team's responsibility to inform Netball Singapore of any intention of a walkover 5 working days in advance. Failure to do so will incur a penalty of \$50.

11. First Aid & Insurance

- **Teams are to prepare their own first aid kits and ice packs to treat injuries.**
- All players are advised to purchase adequate personal accident insurance. For the 2027 National League, Netball Singapore is working with title sponsor Singlife to offer exclusive deals on personal accident plans.

12. Liability

- Netball Singapore and its sponsors shall not be liable for any accidents, injuries, or loss of personal property arising from this event.
- Photos and videos taken during the event may be used for Netball Singapore's marketing and promotional purposes.
